- **PS&E:** Aesthetics design is under coordination and development. The 60% plans were submitted to TxDOT on February 3, 2020.
- Utilities: Plans adequate for utility coordination were submitted in December 2019.
- **ROW:** There are 57 parcels for acquisition in CSJ: 0009-12-219. There are 3 parcels in appraisals, 28 in ED, and 26 parcels acquired.
