<u>Juveniles</u>

Definitions

Juveniles - anyone who is age 16 or younger at the time the alleged violation occurred and required to appear in court with a parent or guardian.

Minor- anyone who is 17 years of age and under 21 years of age and required to appear in court for alcohol and tobacco offenses.

Juveniles appearance

All juveniles will be mailed a court date to the address listed on the citation. Failure to appear will result in a parental summons being issued. Upon service of the parental summons and if the parent fails to bring the juvenile to court a citation for Failure to comply with a parental summons will be issued to the parent.

Minors appearance

All minors alleged to have committed alcohol offenses or tobacco offenses will be set for a court appearance.
