ROCKWALL MUNICIPAL COURT STANDING ORDERS

STANDING ORDER NO. 6—DEFERRED DISPOSITION FOR MOVING VIOLATIONS

The Court Orders that the Court Clerk may process a request for Deferred Disposition (Deferred) of a moving violation if:

- 1. Defendant makes the request by mail or in person at the courthouse;
- 2. Defendant is 18 years of age or older;
- 3. Defendant is at least twenty-five years of age, or if under 25 years of age but at least 18 years of age, the Defendant agrees to complete a driver safety course under section 1001 of the Texas Education Code;
- 4. Defendant requests Deferred;
- 5. Defendant shows proof of valid driver's license in effect at the time of the citation;
- 6. Defendant's driver's license is not a restricted license or a provisional license;
- 7. Defendant pays all court costs and fees associated with the citation, including the special expense fee, and any other fees, in full at the time of the request for Deferred;
- 8. Defendant has not been granted Deferred in the Rockwall Municipal Court within the 12 months preceding the date of the citation and the Defendant is seeking Deferred for only one violation; and
- 9. Defendant is not currently on Deferred in any other jurisdiction.

If these conditions are met, then it is ORDERED that disposition of the citation shall be deferred for 90 days.

The Court Clerk cannot process a request by a Defendant for Deferred for a moving violation if:

- 1. The Defendant holds a commercial driver's license;
- 2. The offense occurred in a construction or maintenance work zone when workers were present;
- 3. The citation involved a moving violation wherein the Defendant was involved in an accident resulting in property damage or personal injury;

- 4. The offense involves passing a school bus while it is loading or unloading;
- 5. The offense involves failing to obey a school crossing guard;
- 6. The offense involves speeding in excess of 25 miles per hour or more over the posted speed limit or was in excess of 95 miles per hour; or
- 7. The case is in "Warrant Status."
