PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICE SPACE ADDED

In the current fiscal year budget, the Rockwall City Council approved funding to accommodate the provision of muchneeded additional office space for some of the city's public safety personnel. Staff from the Fire Administration, Fire Marshal, and Police Department recently moved into a 22,000 sq. ft. office space. The new offices became a necessity over the last several years as both the Fire and Police Departments have notably grown.

"Several Fire Marshal staff members were officing out of bedrooms at one of the fire stations, and the work areas for police department staff have been overcrowded for quite some time. As the City has added new firefighters, utilizing those bedrooms for office space was no longer an option, and police personnel needed more space too. We're fortunate to have this additional 22k square feet to accommodate our needs without having to issue debt, a win-win for both staff as well as tax payers," said City Manager, Mary Smith.
