# **TEMPORARY CHANGE IN WATER DISINFECTANT**

The North Texas Municipal Water District (NTMWD) will implement its annual temporary change in water disinfectant beginning in March for approximately one month. This routine maintenance ensures water quality and safety by using chlorine-only disinfection during this period. Residents may notice a slight change in taste or smell, but the water remains safe to drink and use. The process, required by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality, includes ongoing testing to meet safety standards. TxDOT is launching significant projects in Rockwall, including the widening of I-30 bridges over John King Blvd and FM 3549/Stodghill Rd. Expect closures of on-ramps to the Interstate. These upgrades will involve adding lanes in the center of the existing bridges. Both eastbound and westbound frontage roads between Ridge Road and Hwy 205 will undergo transformations. TxDOT will lay down temporary pavement to facilitate traffic while the current roads are being revamped. The substructure for the I-30 eastbound frontage road on the lake is nearing completion, and drilling has started on the westbound side. Residents should expect various lane closures on I-30 and the adjoining frontage roads as these expansions and improvements take place. #### TIPS FROM TRAVIS SALES, DIRECTOR OF PARKS AND REC

February is the ideal time to prepare your landscape and equipment for the busy spring season ahead. Start by sharpening or replacing your mower blades and giving your mower some care with an oil change and a new air filter. Inspect your irrigation system thoroughly and make any needed repairs to ensure everything is in top shape when watering season arrives.

Before March 1st, focus on pruning your trees, cutting back ornamental grasses and perennial plants, and planting new trees and shrubs. Mid to late February is also the perfect time to apply a pre-emergent herbicide to prevent spring and summer weeds from taking over. By tackling these tasks now, you'll set the stage for a healthy, thriving landscape this spring!
