City Council Candidate Forum

The City of Rockwall will host a Candidate Forum for the contested Rockwall City Council seats in the upcoming election. The event will take place on Wednesday, April 16, at 6:00 PM at The Center (108 E. Washington St., Rockwall, TX 75087). The event will be open to the public and also live-streamed so residents have ample opportunity to view the forum.

The City Council General Election is scheduled for Saturday, May 3, 2025, for the purpose of electing three City Councilmembers – one each for Places 1, 3, 5, and Mayor. Terms for all elected City Councilmembers are for a period of two years.

TxDOT is launching significant projects in Rockwall, including the widening of I-30 bridges over John King Blvd and FM 3549/Stodghill Rd. Expect on-ramp closures to the Interstate. These upgrades will involve adding lanes in the center of the existing bridges. Both eastbound and westbound frontage roads between Ridge Road and Hwy 205 will undergo transformations. TxDOT will lay down temporary pavement to facilitate traffic while the current roads are being revamped. The substructure for the I-30 eastbound frontage road on the lake is nearing completion, and drilling has started on the westbound side. Residents should expect various lane closures on 1-30 and the adjoining frontage roads as these expansions and improvements take place. Travis' Toolbox

TIPS FROM TRAVIS SALES, DIRECTOR OF PARKS AND REC

With spring's arrival, it's time to give your lawn the attention it needs to thrive. Start by scalping your turfgrass at least one inch lower than where you finished last season. This removes dormant brown grass and allows new growth to emerge more easily. Ideally, Hybrid Bermudagrass should be maintained at 1 to 2 inches, while St. Augustine thrives at 2 to 4 inches. Fertilization is key to a strong lawn. The first application should be made when about 50% of your grass has turned green, typically before April 1st. Continue fertilizing in March, June, July, and October, applying 1 to 1.5 pounds of nitrogen per 1,000 square feet during each cycle to maintain a yearly total of 4 to 6 pounds. Your lawn also needs about 1 inch of water per week, whether from rainfall or irrigation. To encourage a dense, weed-resistant turf, aim to mow twice per week throughout the growing season. Did you know? Turfgrass doesn't actively start growing until the combined daytime and nighttime temperatures reach at least 140°F. Keep an eye on the weather, and get ready for a lush, green lawn this spring!
